

The January book selection was **Red Notice: A Story of High Finance, Murder, and One Man's Fight for Justice** by Bill Browder.

This nonfiction book reads like a thrilling novel. The beginning explains Browder's business background and how he sets up his investment company, Hermitage Capital Management.

Browder then describes his harrowing experiences with Russian oligarchs, his expulsion from Russia and the arrest and killing of his Russian attorney, Sergei Magnitsky.

The remainder of the book describes his actions to fight back; becoming an international crusader for justice. His hard work and determination results in the Magnitsky Act. This act was passed by the House and Senate and was signed into law by President Obama. It allows the US government to sanction the Russian oligarchs and freeze their assets.

This book should appeal to a wide audience and is relevant to today's discussion of Russia's interference in our democracy.
